
Remove roof plugs to reveal the vehicles fixing points. Secure the rear and middle roof brackets by bolting through


the vehicles fixing points using M6x30 hex bolts, M6x20 washers & rubber washers. Secure under the roof using


Secure the front roof brackets by loosening the edge of the roof liner enough to hold the front fixing point tool up to the fixing point. Once in position bolt down through the fixing point, into the bush using M6x30 hex bolts, M6 shakeproof washers, M6x20 washers, and rubber washers.




























Place the remaining roof bars into position. See page 2 for the recommended distances between the roof bars. Once in position push on the lever to secure in place.





Secure the roller spigot to the **left hand roller bracket only** using a M8x20 hex bolt and a M8 shakeproof washer. Ensure that the shakeproof is on the inside of the roller bracket and that the spigot sits flush / straight. Tighten using the supplied tool.


